Assistant Library Director's Report

 - **Tiny Houses** July 28 at 6 pm, Isa Bauer, Tiny House Northeast Project Manager and lead designer, will be at the library for a presentation focused on the basics of planning for and owning a tiny house on wheels; both its challenges and advantages. Living in a tiny house year-round is a topic of rapidly developing debate. Learn why something so "cute" and compact could cause so much discussion!

Librarian's Report

- Youth Services

- "Lights, Camera, READ" flexible format for the teens featuring books based on movies. The teen room has been tricked out based on the theme.
- o Mail Chimp has 76 recipients of the youth services newsletter.
